- HALL WATER #16-51 FADDEN & LUNDGREN & CARRIED that Council accepts the proposal from Oak Drive Enterprise for a water softener, iron remover and flow restriction system for the Bergland Community Hall.
- SURFACE #16-52 FADDEN & LUNDGREN & CARRIED that Council authorizes the Road Supt to proceed with surface treatment on Bergland Cemetery Rd (.5km) and Vauthey Rd (1km) the estimated cost is \$6.15 per square meter.
- BRUSHING#16-53 MOEN & FADDEN & CARRIED that Council accepts the proposal from Armor Construction pursuant to our Ditch and Drain Brushing request for Proposals No 16-01. This being the lower of two proposals received. COUNCILLOR LUNDGREN DECLARED A CONFLICT AS HE OWNS LANDS ON ONE OF THE DRAINS.
