The internet provision project for Treaty 3 First Nation and some surrounding municipalities. The project helps improve health care services as well as connectivity to remote communities. The project is to be completed by the end of 2025 and will provide internet service to a portion of the Township. The Kemp's thanked the community for the fire service provided during a recent house fire that destroyed their home. They also had some operational questions for the department and Council will address these at the next Fire Board meeting. They are interested in purchasing a small piece of municipal property next to their home and Council will look at the matter during the upcoming road patrol.

The Rd Supt reported on road work including plowing
